Payments shall be made as follows:

Deposit in the amount of \$7,000USD payable to ALIA Prod (W9 attached) due March 30, 2022; balance of \$11,000USD due for Part II of this residency due by or before May 7, payable to Lakou Mizik (see attached W9). Please note 30% of fee must be withheld and sent to IRS for the 30% tax with-holding required when there is no tax waiver for a tour. Please return signed contract by April 30, 2022.

The Agreement of the Artist to perform is subject to proven detention by sickness, accident, riot, acts of God, or any other legitimate conditions (including pandemics!) beyond their control and Artist shall not be responsible for Sponsor's expenses in such event. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, Artist and Presenter will work in good faith to reschedule the performance, and any payments paid by the Presenter will be applied to the rescheduled performance.

Artist will observe all local/state/national guidelines re COVID protocols. All members of the touring party are fully vaccinated, and will wear masks as needed. Artist expects all venue staff to be fully vaccinated and to wear masks also following local guidelines. Artist prefers audience members also show proof of vaccination. For audience who are not vaccinated, Artist prefers they show negative proof of COVID test taken within 48 hours prior to performance. The wearing of masks for audience will depend on local and state government protocols. For outdoor events above protocols may not be pertinent. The content, nature, and medium of the program shall be
